	Tried by Pilate, Herod	Matthew 27:2-30;	Mark 15:2-19; Luke 23:1-25; John 18:28-19:16
	Crucified and Buried	Matthew 27:31-60;	Mark 15:20-46; Luke 23:26-54; John 19:16-42
SATURDAY	Dead in Tomb		
EASTER SUNDAY	Resurrected	Matthew 28:1-15;	Mark 16:1-8; Luke 24:1-35

- * Mark's Passion Account is chronological; Matthew's Gospel is topical.
- * Matthew and other Gospel writers don't always provide specific time references
- * The above chronology is a very reasonable representation of the sequence of events based on the data provided in the Gospels.
